

Sunnysoft InterWrite 10 :: User Manual



Overview

Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard software displays a unique virtual keyboard on the screen and enables you to use the touch screen to type text in any supported language. Eight modes are available to significantly improve the user experience of inputting on touch screens of handheld devices. It offers a visible feedback of the key currently pressed on the main layouts so you can easily see what key is pressed while moving your finger. Eight keyboard layouts and advanced SmartChoice menu will do its best to fulfil all of your needs.

Software Features

8 keyboard layouts

Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard (IWK) works in eight modes to deliver you the best user experience. You can use the entire screen area to type text with your fingers in Fullscreen, be sure with SMS with Phone keyboard or TapUp, be accurate with great Modern keyboard or stylus-friendly Classic keyboard and write down numbers with three special numpad layouts.

Too complicated for you particular needs? No problem. Just uncheck the box and use only your favorite layout(s)!

IWK has passed a good deal of usability testing as well.

Visualizations

IWK provides accessibility features such as key-press visual feedback. The visual feedback is provided for key taps even while moving your finger on keys around the target zone.

SmartChoice menu

Unique features Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard is a graphical fullscreen menu accessible via Fn button, which is available on any keyboard.

After pressing the Fn button, you will see the Features menu opened, thru which you can comfortably use all the advanced features of IWK:

Changing the language will allow you to select a specific character set, which is then moved into keyboard layouts.

Emoticon simply inserts the popular smilies.

Write @ is the ultimate way to write "at".

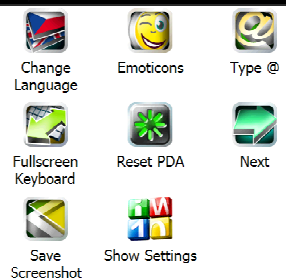
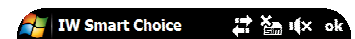
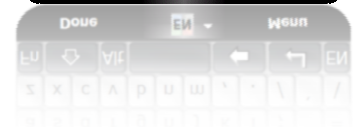
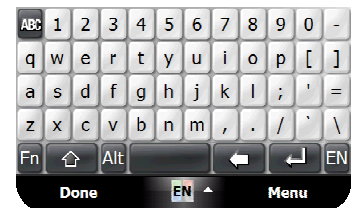
Fullscreen keyboard icon activates the Fullscreen keyboard for comfortable typing.

Reset the PDA will allow you to soft-reset you devices.

App Assign controls unique feature of IWK through which you can choose the desired keyboard layout for each specific application (read more below).

Save screenshot allow you to take a picture of your screen. It is then saved into memory as an image.

Setting is the fastest way to change the basic characteristics of the application.



Charmap allows you to define characters layouts.

Select All, Copy, Paste - popular features for working with text are much easier accessible thanks to SmartChoice

Contrast skin will help you when you need nothing more than black and white keyboard layout, for example, when sun shines too much.

Rotate the screen is the easiest way for the display rotation from portrait mode to landscape mode

The second tab of SmartChoice: the keyboard layouts, thru which you can quickly select the desired keyboard: comfortable for larger quantity of text, with big buttons for text messages or numeric one for Excel Mobile...

The third tab of SmartChoice: programs. Here you can simply add any application installed in the PDA and launch it from anywhere where you new IWK is accessible.

App Assign

Another special feature of IWK is the ability to assign specific keyboard layout to a specific application. You are able set up different keyboard to use for Word, Excel, for text messages, the Internet browser, IM, etc. Each time the application starts, you will get your pre-defined keyboard.

Setup is done simply through a SmartChoice menu: you have to run the application, and then via keyboard Fn key run SmartChoice and press Assign App.

Note: Assign can be changed any time through the IWK settings.

Skins

The layout and appearance of IWK can be fully modified by means of skins. Skins provide additional keyboard interface graphics. You can use the predefined ones or make you own, it is very easy.



Installation

Installation of Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard is a very simple process and takes less than five minutes to complete. The following installation guide will help you.

System Requirements

Make sure your system meets the following minimum requirements before installation: Windows Mobile 5.0, 6.0, and 6.1.

Installing

After you have downloaded the IWK distribution file you should install it to your device. For a successful installation you will need a Pocket PC device attached to your Windows desktop PC. You will also need Microsoft ActiveSync software in order to

install IWK to your device. When you run the software installer on your desktop PC it will ask you to accept the license agreement and will start the installation program. If you already purchased your license, fill in all required information.

You will be prompted for the location where you want the software to be installed. Choose Device memory for best results.

Note: Microsoft ActiveSync works only with Windows XP SP2 or earlier. If you have Windows Vista, your synchronization settings will be managed through the Windows Mobile Device Center. Windows Mobile Device Center is available through the Windows Mobile Device Center page.

Uninstalling

To remove the product from your Device:

1. Go to Start menu > Settings
2. Open System and tap on Remove Programs
3. Select Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard from the list and tap on the Remove button
4. Choose Yes to confirm removing or soft-reset.

Configuring Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard

After IWK is installed on your device it is ready to use. However, you can customize some settings and behaviour.

Sunnysoft InterWrite Keyboard Settings

IWK provides a customizable virtual keyboard interface and behaviour. You can customize such things as the language, skin, suggestion, gestures, App Assign, dictionary and more. To access the configuration utility, run SmartChoice menu and select Settings.

General

Here you can set some very basic: choose IWK as the default system keyboard show original keyboard panel and/or international keyboard panel and enable or disable the today icon.

Keyboard

You are able to choose a graphic look here and add other language layouts.

Layouts

Here you can select which keyboard layouts you want to use and in what order.

Fullscreen

Here you will find all necessary settings for Fullscreen layout: choose graphic, hardware button, sounds and more.

Suggestions

You are able to configure dictionary here. Press the red question mark for more detailed information.

Options

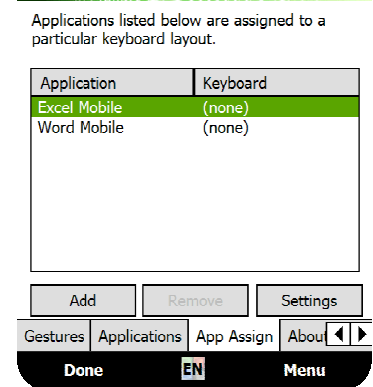
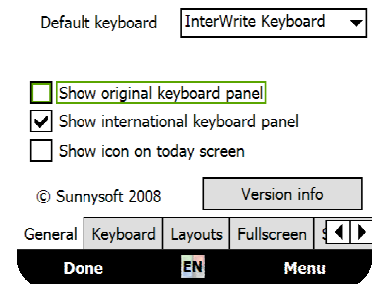
Here you can configure auto repeat rate and delay, recognizer behaviour, and screenshot options.

Gestures

In some keyboard layouts you are able to use smart gestures to enhance your writing experience. You can configure it here.

Applications

Here you see a list of installed application. Simply check the box and you will find it in your SmartChoice menu.



App Assign

You can see a list of applications here which are assigned to a particular keyboard layout. You are able to manage the connections here. Keyboard layout can be assigned to the application via Fn button: launch the desired application, press the Fn button and choose App Assign in SmartChoice menu.

You are able to register a full version in the last tab.

About The Trial Version

The trial version of IWK includes all of the features available in the registered version. The trial version expires within 14 days after the first installation. You can use the trial version only to check how IWK works. In order to keep using the software you need to purchase the license. There is no need to re-install the IWK in order to use the full version.
